2021 WMF Projects

The WMF is a unique arm of the AFLC in that 3/4 of our projects are in support of other departments. They are 1. **Christian Education** (Parish Ed, FLBC, FLS), 2. **Home Missions** and 3. **World Missions** and the 4. **WMF General Fund**. This is a faith budget, what comes in for a project goes out to that project. No one project is more important than the other; it is all the work of God. The Directors and Boards of the AFLC projects that we support know best where the funding that is sent to them could be best used. Designated funds are used for what they are designated for but sometimes the designated giving takes away from other areas in the ministry that must go unmet. To help this situation we designate that the Boards can use funds as they deem necessary. There is much gratitude expressed from those the National WMF meet with for the support that the WMF sends to the departments. 1. CHRISTIAN EDUCATION Budget \$17,000 **August (FLBC and FLS) and November (Parish Ed)**

PARISH ED – Support received will be used toward the Sunday School curriculum updates or as the Parish Education Board deems necessary. FREE LUTHERAN BIBLE COLLEGE – Support will continue to go towards the dorm room refurbishing. Each unit runs about \$1,250 with 74 units remaining as of the beginning of the year. Keep the FLBC students, faculty and staff in prayer. (website: <https://flbc.edu/about-flbc/>).
