March, August, and November  
Yearly budget amount \$65,200

Support received for WMF General Fund will be used to cover necessary expenses. The National Board prepares, prints and distributes the WMF Bible studies, Helping Hand newsletter, fall WMF Resource Manual updates and welcome packets to new congregations. We have the WMF web site ([www.aflc.org/women](http://www.aflc.org/women)), WMF blog ([www.aflc.org/women/blog/](http://www.aflc.org/women/blog/)), Facebook ([www.facebook.com/WomensMissionaryFederation/](http://www.facebook.com/WomensMissionaryFederation/)), and the Pastor's wives blog (Heartline) which is a secure site. Support also covers the administrative costs; salary for the Executive Secretary and stipends for the President and Treasurer. ### WORLD MISSIONS

January, April, July and September

Yearly budget amount \$45,000

The support will be distributed to the AFLC missionaries as the World Missions Board deems necessary. Keep our missionaries and families in prayer. **Mission Scholarship** program: This scholarship program is available to seminarians who are approved as missionary candidates for AFLC World Missions, Short Term Assistants (STA), and Missionary and Seminary wives who desire to continue their spiritual education.
