

MINUTES OF THE ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING OF THE W.M.F. OF THE LUTHERAN FREE CHURCH

(not merged)

The organizational meeting of the W.M.F. of the Lutheran Free Church (not merged) took place at Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Thief River Falls, Minnesota, on October 27, 1962, as a noon dinner meeting.

Mrs. Ole K. Ose acted as chairman of the meeting and called on Mrs. T. F. Dahle to lead in singing our table prayer. Mrs. J. Hermunslie returned thanks after our meal.

The group sang together one stanza of "What a Friend We Have in Jesus", after which Mrs. Ose led us in a time of meditation and sharing based on John 17:21-22. We were reminded that we can have true unity of purpose only as our wills become His will. A short prayer session followed.

We then turned to business, with many ladies taking part, asking questions or giving suggestions. It seemed generally agreed that we should have an entirely new program. Our thoughts turned first to our mission projects. Suggestions given and questions raised were as follows:

- My Missionary for a Day, as such, will be discontinued; would it be possible for us to give to our MMD missionaries through a headquarters of our own?
- It was pointed out that in one case, gifts previously sent directly to a catechist had to be stopped because of the feeling it caused there on the field, and in the same way it may not be wise to send our gifts directly to our missionaries.

Mission Projects suggested were:

- World Mission Prayer League
- A church extension fund to aid congregations needing home mission support
- A mission to the Jews

It was suggested that the conference may be able to suggest a mission field for us. It was also suggested that we have a page in the new paper to be published as the official organ of the church.

We were reminded that we are responsible for our MMD missionaries' salaries for this year of 1962, but were told that what contributions come in over and above what is needed for support of the missionaries will go into the Merger and Missions Fund. It was suggested that each local aid keep their MMD money until the year nears end and then check at headquarters to see if our obligations have been met before sending in any more money. If it is not needed for MMD salaries, our money will be very useful in starting our new W.M.F. work.

Discussion on possible Bible Study materials followed. It was pointed out that if we are not committed to God, our planning is guided by the Devil. Some suggestions for Bible Study material were:

- Use the Bible alone
- L.B.I. correspondence courses
- That we have a literature committee to investigate and suggest material that would be suitable for Ladies Aid work.

A motion was made that we elect a committee to look into Ladies Aid Bible Study Material. It was second and carried.

We then went to election of temporary officers who were to act until the Annual Conference of June, 1963.

Nominations for President were: Mrs. John Strand (who requested that her nomination be retracted. Request granted.)

Mrs. Ole K. Ose was elected.

A motion was made that the forgoing nominees act as officers according to votes received. It was seconded and carried.

A motion was made that the executive board as elected act as a working committee until June. It was seconded and carried.

It was moved and seconded that the meeting be adjourned. Carried.

The executive committee met for a short session after the Saturday afternoon conference sessions, October 27, 1962.

A literature committee was appointed as follows:

On October 27, 1962 during the convention of our church, not merged, about 30 women met for a noon luncheon in Our Saviour's Free Lutheran Church in Thief River Falls to fellowship about the Word and to get acquainted in order to organize the work of the women within the AFLC.

The women are very faithful in their support of these projects. We are amazed to have had our budget goals met and exceeded every year. For this we praise the Lord!

One of the resolutions presented at the first Annual Convention expressed concern for desirable Bible Study literature. It was not long before the WMF was able to contact men and women who consented to write our monthly Bible Studies. These are printed in the Lutheran Ambassador. Articles are also written for the Women's Page in the Lutheran Ambassador. Women write promotional literature on the WMF projects and a devotional service for the World Day of Prayer.

Two opportunities are provided for the WMF women to meet on the National level. On Friday evening of the Mid-Winter Bible Conference, the women of the WMF make provisions for an evening meal and a general workshop. A discussion is held on the WMF projects. Also on the Wednesday preceding the AFLC Annual Convention, the women assemble for an all day session. They also plan for and preside over the Mission Festival Service on Thursday night.
