 - BE IT RESOLVED that we encourage every congregation in the AFLC to consider implementing discipleship training for the laity in order that they would "go and make disciples" (Matt. 28:19);
 - BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we encourage every congregation in the AFLC to utilize the faithful resources of the AFLC Evangelism and Discipleship Ministry.
- 2. WHEREAS the Holy Scriptures exhorts "So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith" (Gal. 6:10),
 - AND WHEREAS the Pastoral and Congregational Care Team (PACCT) has been established to support pastors, their wives, and congregations for encouragement;
 - AND WHEREAS a fund has been created where our people can financially participate in the team's ministry, BE IT RESOLVED that we encourage every congregation in the AFLC to prayerfully consider contributing to the PACCT fund.

 - AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that after prayerful consideration, we approve the subsidy request for 2020 of \$150,395.
