PURPLE Wild Turkey Trail: 1/4 mi. (easy) • link from Mountainside Lodges to Retreat Center

WHITE Fox Run Trail: 1/2 mi. (easy)

RED Whitetail Trail: 2 mi. (moderate)

YELLOW Spruce Mountain Trail: 2 mi. (difficult) • waterfalls and scenic overlook
